Current activities

- Light demolition
- Transports to and from the fenced area on Regeringsgatan, Mästerfaret and Mäster Samuelsgatan
- Crane lifts will occur repeatedly for several months from and around the building
- The scaffolding will be lowered as the demolition moves along



- A safety wall will be mounted along the lane in Mästerfaret



- On Wednesday April 26th between 7am-2pm, loud noises and vibrations due to the demolition are to be expected (by the intersection of Mäster Samuelsgatan and Regeringsgatan).
- Heavy demolition of the top floors continues

Upcoming activities within the next three weeks

- The current activities, stated above, will continue for a few more weeks

Planned activities outside normal working hours

- During weeks 10-18 below activities are planned for after normal working hours:
- Monday-Thursday 4pm-7pm (demolition)
- Saturday-Sunday 8am-5pm (demolition)
- The weekends of April 22-23 between 7am-5pm work will be done at the Mästerfaret's ramp (mounting of forging)

About Project Hästen 21

With the new development, Pembroke creates a modern and sustainable building with office, retail and residential spaces. The new Hästen 21 will open up the neighborhood and with new passages, restaurants and stores we transform one of Stockholm's most central districts into a more accessible and attractive place, 24/7.

The city development project started in August 2022 and the new building is planned to deliver in 2026. It will feature a light natural stone and glass façade, green rooftops and terraces. The architecture is inspired by the existing buildings in the area and the size and height of the Hästen 21 building have been carefully designed to blend in with the cityscape.
